Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) are toxic organic chemical substances that persist in the environment. They can be transported by wind and water, potentially adversely affecting human health and the environment worldwide.

Certain POPs are addressed by the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants with Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of June 20, 2019: <https://echa.europa.eu/list-of-substances-subject-to-pops-regulation>. The list of POPs, which are under the scope of the regulation is periodically extended with new POPs.

M+S Hydraulic PLC supports the objectives of the Stockholm Convention and Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 to protect human health and the environment from exposure to chemical substances that have been identified as POPs.

The Stockholm Convention and (EU) 2019/1021 do not require that M+S Hydraulic PLC provide analysis data for our products. However, we are committed to ensuring the conformity of our products to applicable POPs obligations and providing our customers with actual and respective product information.

All M+S Hydraulic suppliers are also required to eliminate and minimize the environmental impact of the supplying chain thus to be compliant with the Stockholm Convention and (EU) 2019/1021 requirements as well as to work towards elimination of POPs that remain in the environment and are risk to human health.
